Major Event Security Principles

The event must take into consideration the entire community (theatre of Operations) surrounding the venues, to include the key assets and infrastructure supporting the event..... Terrorists do not have to focus on the venues to be successful at making a statement at an event

- ▶ It is impossible to make an event 100% secure
 - ▶ Possible to reduce threats and vulnerabilities
